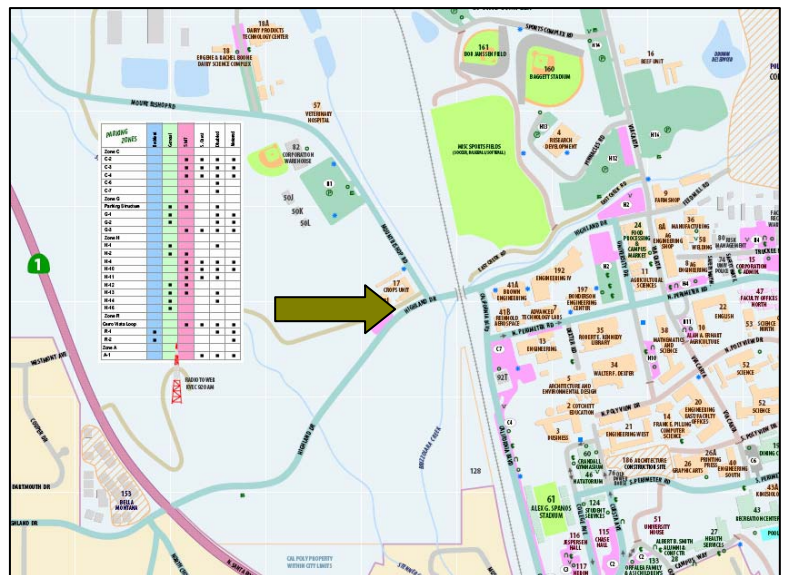
Exit 101 on HWY 1 West
